While in talk with Chokri Literature Committee (language authority) – those taking initiative for preservation and development of the Chokri language, the progress have been slow and meticulous as series of consultation and advice were sought from many stakeholders. While early works have been printed in maiden edition, corrective works have been ensued as the language is still in evolutionary stage.

There is a high level of anticipation from the people for language work that have ease of reading and understanding. On learning about the project to provide an audio guidebook of Chokri language in multi-media (Audio) format have been received with lots of expectations. The goal of the project is to provide audio guide to and digitalize the language handbook - for wide audience in multiplatform such as computer, internet, android etc have been made clear. The guidebook therefore is aimed at simplifying pronunciation of the Chokri words. This is considered having high value as pronunciation of newly formed words in different pronunciation pitches is considered to be strangely difficult for the users.

In this process many meetings have taken place with various social and cultural leaders and authorities in villages and towns as follows:

- 1) Meeting with Mr. Yesai, Elder of Chepoketa Village, Phek District. (June 10, 2015)
- 2) Meeting with Chokri Language Krotho (Jule 22, 2015)
- 3) Meeting with Z. Vadeo Pioneer in development Chokri language.

4) Meeting with community leader of Phusachodu Village (Mr.

5) Second Meeting with Z Vadeo & Seve - - Students Union President.

While performing activities mentioned above, the files in the

attachment are preliminary audio recordings acquired during the process

and unedited. The audio files are only a beginning and 90 % of more

recording needed to follow as per convenience of the orator.

Meanwhile, a new and revised translation of more words is being

carried out simultaneously which are to be incorporated as and when the

work is finalized. The Committee desires the framework of the guidebook

to be in the format as being published in book form while incorporating

other audio facilities.

Moreover, the phonetics guide for pronunciation guide and alphabets

have been developed from scratch. Therefore, high expectations is put on

the development of the digital audio guidebook sponsored by Sangeet

Natak Akademy under ICH.

In due course annual meet of the language committee is to be held

which is expected to bring new contributions for the development of Chokri

language.

Finally, best digital audio guidebook maker in full version shall be

acquired for maximum features such as word/ page audio

linking/incorporation and output to various platform such as smart phones

Mac and PC platforms, Video CD/DVD digital audio book.
