The shadow puppet theatre of Kerala-India

Tholpava koothu is believed to have originated the 9th or 10th century A.D this traditional puppet play of Kerala state is still being conducted annually it so many considered as a temple festival and it will last from 7days to 14,21,41,71 days .without any break according to the temple customs prevailing in each temple for 6 to 8 hours .the show start 10pm every nigh and will be continued till 5.30am. All theatres are being constructed adjacen to the temple of the goddess *Bhadra kali*. It is believed that the goddess will be pleased to watch the show and bless the devotes. This Tolpavakoothu is completely based on "Kamba Ramayana" and the language used in its performance is also Tamil. The fight between Sree Rama and Ravana and the fight between Bhadra kali and Darikasura (demon king) took place at the same time. And hence the goddess Bhadra kali could not see the war between Sree Rama and Ravana this was brought to the notice of lord Shiva in turn told her to go the earth and remain in temples. Being in the puppet show it which the fight between Sree Rama and Ravana will be shown.

In whole over the world only kerala is performing the show in a ritualistic way in temples in late nights. Only in the world we are only having the permanent puppet theatre. The artist in kerala are not just performing they are talented in Vedas, Puranas, Ethihasas, and all songs and meanings. So the nex generation should be about this and should e well known about our culture and heritage so we have to digitalize all our documents.

The artforms is having its own ritual and cultural importance. In olden days there were many scholars who are performing the show ritualistically. Now

after the arrival of new media the art form is facing many challenges lack of audience and not having an interest in studying this art in young generation. So we are having the ritualistic show performing from the month of January to June every year in our permanent puppet theatre.

In our hand we are having only countable well known scholars in this field. So what we have do is that we have meet them and digitalize all the songs and Puranas which they will recite in temples ritually. And digitalize all the documents, books, their voice songs and meanings, and all related to Tholpavakoothu completely.

It will really be very helpful to the coming generation and all research people who need all document related to Tholpavakoothu. Otherwise the scholars are very aged and the next generation can hear the voice and recite it and study. They can use it as study material. It really it will be very helpful if we digitalize all related to Tholpavakoothu.

And will seek help from research scholars from different departments of kerala depend on different category of Folk, Drama, Theatre performing arts.

The materials that we have to use we have to record around more than 600 hours from the temples audio documentation as well as video. We keep it in our archives which will really helpful for the practioners, research people and all related ones.

The banks of this river is owning its own unique culture and having all temples and Koothumadam.

In our hand we are having only countable well known scholars in this field. And digitalize all the documents, books, their voice songs and meanings, and all related to Tholpavakoothu completely.

Project Report

Krishnan kutty pulavar memorial Tholpavakoothu & puppet centre is very happy and thankful to Indian cultural heritage and Sangeet natak academy new Delhi for support of the presentation of the palm leaf manuscript the valuable documents written by our ancestors wrote in 8th century. These are very much safe and it wants to be protected.

My application I mentioned the three volumes of the kamba Ramayana consists of 12,126 songs and meaning our ancestors had compressed it into 3,126 songs considering the shadow puppetry (Tholpavakoothu form) which is molded in the palm leaf manuscripts.

My 1st and 2nd progress report proposal concentrates the 1st and 2nd kanda of 600 songs with meaning and explanation narrations and specific instructions my ancestors handwritten dawn in these palm leaf manuscripts should be converted or copied into a cd and document it. I finish the 3rd step scanned the palm leaf manuscripts this is 300 pages in ayodhyakanda. In our project proposal I fully scanned up to 900 pages documented for the preservations and it was very much useful for the upcoming generation for enriching the deep knowledge in the art form in that palm leaf lot of detailed texts consisting of songs,vedha,puranas, astrology, science, ayurvedha, and about the Ramayana that our ancestors had written very clearly and thoroughly . these three stages are completed scan all the 2 kandas "Bala Kandam" and Ayodhya Kandam" total 900 songs. During this period I fully scanned all the palmleaf manuscript .

Our ancestor those who written and the text in the palmleaf manuscript.now days itz not usge friend because all of them are digitlized .and also some kind of insects

are effect some laef and that are possiblt to read.so the coming generation are very much afraid to use the palm leaf manuscript. S othat protection of the plamleaf manuscript is verymuch need to the Tholpavakoothu artist and all researches. I fulled polished all the palmleaf manuscript use with the pull thail (one of the medicine to protect the plam leaf).

The palm leaf texts the younger generation can't read it now because the book reading and palm leaf text reading is different it requires an extra kind of reading. So that's why the Sangeet Natak Academys financial help assistance is very helpful to our new generation. These palm leaf all the real texts that our ancestors are used for the studying and all collection of the valuable documents already scan 900 pages of all the palm leaf text and convert it in digitalize text for the future generation for the simply usage to study the Tholpavakoothu texts and documents. There are all together around 2256 pages for the whole Kambaramayana manuscript .for this project I done around 900 more pages scanned and protect all the manuscript and convert into digitalize this can easily go all of them .

In this project period to make 900 page document of palm leaf manuscripts handwritten of balakanda and ayodhyakandam RS.75000 has been sanctioned. I hope ICH will sanction that amount so we can complete the project soon.
